People of all ages come to Bromley House to read, work, study and socialise in the many rooms of our Grade II* listed Georgian building in the heart of the city.

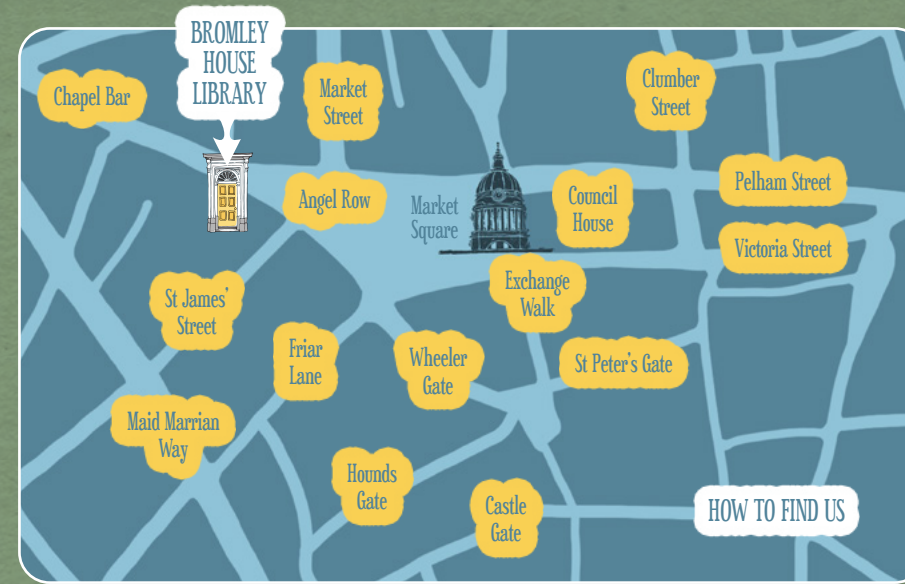
Your membership will include access to:

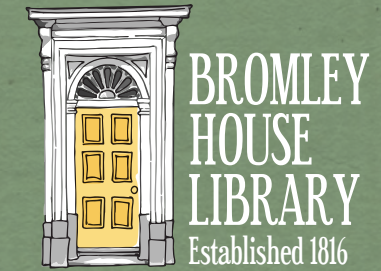

- Complete the application form enclosed in this pack, or you can download a form from our website.

- **You can join the library at any time,** however our main intake is on the first working day of each month. Once enrolled we will send you a welcome e-mail with an attached information pack, and you can start using the library straight away, as long as we have received payment and your identification has been verified.

- We will request payment from you once your application has been processed and you are enrolled as a new member. If paying by Direct Debit please submit the completed form with your application. This is our preferred method as it helps to reduce administrative costs. If paying by cash, cheque, card or bank transfer, please wait until we contact you on your enrolment day before making payment.
